

Cookie Policy

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile device by the websites that you visit.

Cookies are widely used in order to make websites work more efficiently, and/or enhance the user experience, as well as providing information to the owners of the site (i.e. for making customer-focused improvements to the site).

The law that applies to how cookies are used for storing information on your equipment (such as your computer or mobile device) changed on 26 May 2011.

The following information covers how our sites use cookies, and how to disable them if you wish.

If you disable cookies, it may prevent you from using some of the features on our websites (e.g. completing some of our online forms), or it may prevent us from collecting enough data to identify where we need to improve our site (e.g. Google Analytics).

We do not collect personal information through cookies.

Any information we collect via cookies is used anonymously, simply to improve our online services and enhance your experience of our websites. We will not use the information to identify individuals and only share this data with sub-contractors who build and maintain our website.
